- Village Survey update The survey is now at Leiston press who are making a few amendments prior to the leaflet being printed. The cost of printing (£170) was agreed by all councillors.
- Residential development in Reydon. Appears to be all quiet at the moment and Cllr S
 Farrands is monitoring the situation. Orbit housing are due to give another
 presentation at Reydon in the coming weeks.
- Post Office closure/mobile van. No consultation was given and no approach was made to the PC about parking. The decision has been made.
- Tennis court (muga) entry system. Cllr S. Smith with a company to discuss both manual or electronic entry systems and is awaiting a quote.

- Pest Control Contract. A new contract has been agreed with the pest control
 contractor. This will include 8 visits a year and free call outs if necessary. A number of
 extra bait boxes have been purchased as there has been an increase in the number
 of rats. Cllrs S. Smith and G. Pepper will meet to discuss the potential increase in plot
 rent to cover additional costs and report back to the PC.
- Parish Clerk vacancy the position is still being advertised.
